

Registration Form

Before completing the registration and participation agreement forms please ensure you possess the following EMDRIA's Prerequisites for Basic Training:

A-Licensed Clinical Professionals

- ❖ Medical doctors who are licensed in their province or state.
- ❖ Registered nurses with a Master's Degree and specialization in mental health and are licensed in their province or state.
- ❖ Mental health clinicians with a Master's Degree (e.g., Counseling, Marriage and Family Therapy, Psychology, Psychiatry, Social Work) and are currently licensed by a professional organization with a code of ethics.

B-Pre-Licensed Clinical Professionals

- ❖ Clinicians actively seeking a mental health license through their provincial, state, or national regulatory body while working under the supervision of a licensed professional (e.g., intern, associate).
- ❖ Clinicians who possess a Master's Degree in a mental health discipline and are pursuing full licensure through their provincial, state, or national regulatory body.

C-Non-Licensed Therapists or Who Are Not Yet Licensed for Clinical Practice

- ❖ Complete the Non-Licensed Therapists Section and return to Sidney as soon as possible on page three.
- ❖ Provide a letter from your clinical supervisor that confirms you are on a licensing track and may send this separately at a later time.
- ❖ Only if applicable: If you have a Master's degree in Art Therapy, Christian/Pastoral Counseling, Drug/Alcohol Counseling, and Music Therapy EMDRIA will need to review your transcript and approve your education and licensure status. You are required to provide evidence of EMDRIA's approval via an email or letter in support of this application.

D-Graduate Students

- ❖ Applicants must be currently enrolled in a Master's or Doctoral program in a mental health discipline such as Counseling, Marriage and Family Therapy, Psychology, Psychotherapy, Psychiatry, or Social Work. Essential that graduate academic coursework should be completed, and you have completed or currently engaged in the practicum/internship component of your graduate studies. First-year graduate students are ineligible. Furthermore, it is required that graduate students are on a licensing track and working under the supervision of a licensed mental health professional.

To assure prompt processing of your registration application please include the following items in order to avoid delay in processing the registration application:

- ❖ A copy of your Master or Doctoral Diploma
- ❖ A copy of your liability insurance if in private practice
- ❖ A copy of your license/registration as a mental health provider
- ❖ Copy of a current Curriculum Vitae
- ❖ Letters required for Non- Licensed or Non-Registered applicants
- ❖ Letter from a Registrar's Office confirming full-time student status
- ❖ Participant Agreement Form

Non-Licensed Therapist Application

To be completed by non-licensed clinicians and those not yet licensed for independent practice. If this does not apply you may skip this section.

The application package for non-licensed clinicians and clinicians who are not yet licensed for independent practice must provide evidence of:

- ❖ Meeting EMDRIA educational qualifications
- ❖ Having an appropriate supervised clinical setting
- ❖ Being in the process of moving toward licensure for independent practice. You will do this by submitting a statement and letter along with your application package.

This form has the following requirements:

1. Complete the Statement of Current Practice information that includes an explanation of your current practice.
2. Provide a letter from clinical supervisor that can be submitted separately.
3. If your master's degree is in Art Therapy, Christian/Pastoral Counseling, Drug/Alcohol Counseling, and Music Therapy you must have EMDRIA approve your educational status and submit a letter from them to that effect. This can be submitted separately. Your application will not be reviewed without submission of these materials.

Requirement 2. Letter from Clinical Supervisor (required for non-licensed therapists)

Provide a letter from your licensed clinical supervisor providing licensure supervision. This letter should document the following items:

- ❖ Verification of your licensure track.
- ❖ The anticipated date for licensure to be achieved.
- ❖ Verification that you maintain an active psychotherapy caseload under their supervision that includes clients who present with trauma.
- ❖ Agency/practice name, supervisor's name & position with their contact information.
- ❖ A statement of support endorsing you to participate in this training. Please make sure that all of these items are addressed in the supervisor's letter. Your registration will not be considered complete until the supervisor's letter is received.

If Applicable - Documentation from EMDRIA for Certain Degree Fields

Mental Health Clinicians who have a Master's degree in one of the following fields must submit their graduate transcript to EMDRIA to determine their eligibility: Art Therapy, Christian/Pastoral Counseling, Drug/Alcohol Counseling, and Music Therapy. If EMDRIA approves your education and licensure status, please submit approval documentation from EMDRIA with your application.

You must be enrolled as a fulltime student and have completed your first year of your program. Please include the additional documentation described in the Non-Licensed Applicant Instructions. Graduate students who are enrolled in a Master's program in one of the following fields must first submit their graduate course transcript to EMDRIA to determine eligibility: Art Therapy, Christian/Pastoral Counseling, Drug/Alcohol Counseling, and Music Therapy.

This form has the following requirements:

1. Complete the Graduate Student Information.
2. Provide a letter from your clinical supervisor. This can be submitted separately and can be the same letter as for the Non-Licensed Therapists.
3. Provide an unofficial transcript from your graduate program's institution.
4. If your master's degree is in Art Therapy, Christian/Pastoral Counseling, Drug/Alcohol Counseling, and Music Therapy you must have EMDRIA approve your educational status and submit a letter from them to that effect and can be submitted separately.

- ❖ A statement of support endorsing your participation in this training. Please ensure that all of these items are addressed in the supervisor's letter.

Requirement 3. Unofficial transcript from your graduate program / institution.
